RECERTIFICATION SAFETY POINTS

Praesidium's organizational values are expertise, passion, impact, collaboration, and innovation. But these are not just words to us. We live these values every day and they are the foundation that drives our mission to help you protect those in your care from abuse and to help preserve trust in your organization. So naturally, the Safety Points learning activities that enable you to become re-certified as a Praesidium Certified Guardian fall under these five value categories. There are multiple options under each value and no one Safety Point or value is more important than another. Just like your entire Praesidium Guardian experience, we are committed to accommodating different learning styles and professional preferences for making an impact

Praesidium Guardian Certification is valid for 3 years. Before that 3-year expiration, Guardians must complete **30 Safety Points** in order to renew certification for 3 more years. Safety Points can be obtained under any value, in any order, at any time throughout those 3 years. See the chart on page 5 to read more about the learning activities that result in attaining Safety Points.




RECOMMENDATIONS

MAINTAIN YOUR PRAESIDIUM GUARDIAN CERTIFICATION WITH CONTINUOUS LEARNING

It is our opinion that a Certified Praesidium Guardian is most well-rounded when Safety Points are achieved from learning activities within each value. However, that may not be possible or preferred for some, so it is not required but highly encouraged.

It is also our opinion that a Certified Praesidium Guardian is best equipped to sustain a culture of safety within their organization if there is ongoing learning, so it is our recommendation that Safety Points are obtained each year throughout the 3-year certification, rather than completing all Safety Points near the end of the certification period. But this program is designed to meet you where you are, so it is not required to obtain Safety Points annually.

Your status as a Certified Praesidium Guardian™ demonstrates to consumers and other stakeholders how seriously your organization takes the care and safety of their loved



We encourage you to explore creative ways to show what you have achieved and showcasing your Safety Points activities in an online portfolio is a great way to do this. According to HubSpot, "an online portfolio is a digital collection of information about your past work, experiences, qualifications, skills, or accolades you have earned and want to share on the web. They give legitimacy to your work and provide industry professionals with a better understanding of what you can do." While this is not required, you do earn 3 Safety Points in putting your portfolio together if you choose to do so and is a great way to share your knowledge with your current organization, your peers, or future employers.
